# 2K, solvent-based acrylic clearcoat for cementitious floors



#### **General information**

## **Technical features**

Solvent-based clearcoat based on acrylic resins and non-yellowing cross linking agents. The product has a good aesthetic appearance and surface hardness and is also suitable for outdoor application thanks to the aliphatic polymers.

## **Application field**

Product ideal as clear, acrylic topcoat to be applied both as anti-dust, thin film thickness coat on new, rough or uncoated cementitious floors, and as transparent protective coat on previously applied, colored coats to guarantee greater durability and resistance outdoors and indoors.

## SUBSTRATE PREPARATION

- •New floor: to carry out the work properly, it is necessary to verify the absorption of the substrate pouring some water on the support to be coated in order to ensure sufficient porosity to the cement surface before coating it. If the water is rapidly absorbed, the substrate is in optimal conditions to be coated. Otherwise it is not porous enough and the surface must be chemically treated as follows: accurately wash the floor with an acid solution consisting of 1 part of muriatic acid and 9 parts of water. After the chemical reaction, rinse with water and after complete drying proceed coating the floor.
- Already coated floor: mechanically remove old paint, not compliant coatings, oils, greases, rubber-abraded coatings and friable material.

## **APPLICATION**

## Application conditions

The application with a brush or short-haired roller for enamels is recommended. To guarantee the homogeneity of the product with the hardener, it is necessary to follow the instructions: pour the hardener (component B) into the transparent base (component A); mix with an electric stirrer with motor speed at 300-400 rpm. After the catalysis, let the product rest for 5-10 minutes, dilute with Thinner for Polyurethanes and Acrylics series D0003 and apply the product. Apply the first coat diluted at 5-10%; after 12-24 hours but no later than 3-4 days, apply one coat of the product ready to be used or diluted at 5% with Thinner for Polyurethanes and Acrylics Serie D0003.

# WARNINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- Shelf Life Component B: the shelf life of the hardener used with Component A is 12 months.
- Check for the presence of moisture in the substrate: it must not exceed 4%.
- Before applying any coating, it is advisable to carry out the "plastic sheet" test, according to Standard ASTM D 4263-83, to check for any problem caused by excessive rising moisture and/or counter-thrust water.
- •The floor must have a minimum compressive strength of 25 N/mm<sup>2</sup> and tensile strength of 1,5 N/mm<sup>2</sup>.
